## Course Description

Children with urologic conditions present frequently in the practice of both the general urologist as well as the pediatrician. Two of the most common challenges that are currently undergoing an intense reevaluation in their management are vesicoureteral reflux and cryptorchidism.

Treatment strategies and techniques for these conditions are being expanded and refined. As a result of more choices and a more nuanced approach to patients with these disorders, clinicians should integrate a thorough assessment of the pathophysiology that these conditions present.

- ✓ Evaluate treatment options for a child with vesicoureteral reflux so that the risk of renal scarring is minimized
- ✓ Diagnose and initiate therapy for routine urologic complaints in children with minimal invasiveness and in a cost effective manner
- ✓ Perform ambulatory pediatric urologic surgeries with improved outcomes and decreased complications
- ✓ Recognize methods of evaluation for children with common urologic symptoms, so as to efficiently diagnose and determine a treatment protocol that will properly manage and resolve the condition
- ✓ Evaluate treatment options for children with cryptorchidism in order to improve the likelihood of preserving testicular function and viability
