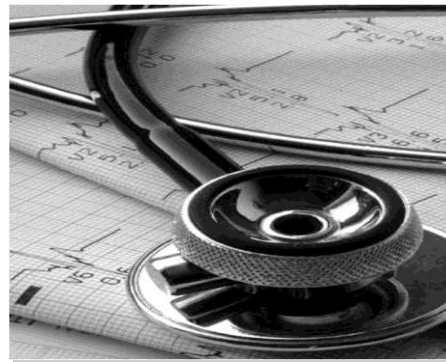

ADVANCES IN MULTI-SPECIALTY AESTHETIC AND RECONSTRUCTIVE PLASTIC SURGERY SYMPOSIUM & BERNARD G. SARNAT, MD LECTURESHIP

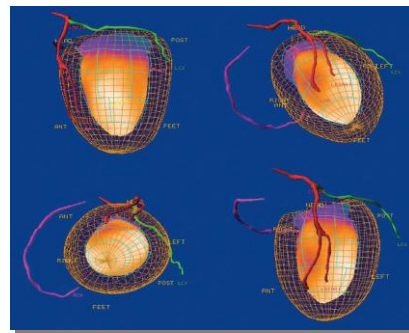
