The following are highlights from the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Medical Executive Committee Meeting:

**Ebola Response/Update:**

Mark Gavens and Dr. Langberg provided an update on CSMC's preparedness to treat an Ebola patient at CSMC. Information will continue to be disseminated as appropriate.

**TJC Site Visit**

We are expecting a TJC Site Visit between now and the end of the year. Information regarding preparation for the site visit has been distributed by email from the Chief of Staff and has been referenced in multiple PULSE e-newsletters. Please become familiar with this information.

**Medical Staff Rules & Regulations Revision Approved:**

Article II, Section 2.5 – The Chief of Staff currently has “the duty to act as the Medical Staff's delegate in urgent legal and regulatory matters impacting the Medical Staff” in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer and the Vice-Chief of Staff; the MEC will be notified within 24 hours of any action, and will vote on the action at the next MEC meeting. In light of the rapid and frequent changes in the local and national response to Ebola, a revision of this section was made to include “public health matters” in the duties of the Chief of Staff.
