Stroke has become the 3rd largest cause of mortality in the United States and currently kills 150,000 annually. Stroke can be embolic, ischemic or hemorrhagic in nature, and is the leading cause of long-term disability. Transcranial Doppler (TCD) is a non-invasive, painless, and mobile ultrasound technique that can be utilized to help diagnose first time, and secondary stroke risk. It can be used in the ICU, ER, OR, or at bedside, and has been mandated an integral part of the technology provided by the Comprehensive Stroke Center.
