## PARKING RATE CHANGES: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What will the new parking rates be?

Parking rates will be tiered based on each employee's hourly rate, similar to our tiered benefits model, which also is based on compensation:

HOURLY RATE	PARKING RATE
\$20/hr and below	\$17/month
\$20.01—\$35/hr	\$40/month
\$35.01—\$60/hr	\$56/month
\$60.01/hr +	\$100/month

### Who will be affected?

All full-time, part-time and per-diem Cedars-Sinai Medical Center employees, independent contractors and faculty physicians who pay for parking.

### When will the rates take effect?

New rates will take effect in November. The new deduction will be reflected in your Nov. 15 paycheck.

### Why are rates changing?

Our organization has been working hard to identify ways in which we can operate more efficiently. For more than two decades, Cedars-Sinai has maintained parking rates and subsidized much of the cost of parking for our employees and patients. Now, we are adjusting our parking rates to reflect current industry standards.

### Is my parking spot going to change?

We are re-evaluating parking lot assignments to ensure employees are parking as close as possible to their assigned work areas. You will be notified if your lot assignment changes.

**What do other hospital employees in the area pay for parking?**

Cedars-Sinai maintains competitive employee parking rates. We believe our tiered approach—structured like our benefits approach and based on compensation—sets our rates at a reasonable cost. In most cases, our rates are still much lower than those of our healthcare counterparts.

**I’m enrolled in the Rideshare program. Will anything change?**

No, but if you have a parking spot assigned to you, that monthly deduction will change based on your hourly rate. However, you will continue to be reimbursed for the full cost of your spot, so long as you continue to meet Rideshare participation requirements.

**Where can I get more information on the Rideshare Program?**

The Rideshare Program provides many options for commuting to work, including subsidies for public transit. For example, we are doubling our monthly subsidy for bus and Metro passes from \$50 to \$100. Office hours are 7 a.m.-3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

**I’m a volunteer. Do I have to pay?**

No. Volunteers will continue to receive free parking.

**Are patient/visitor parking rates changing?**

Yes. New daily parking rates for our patients and visitors will take effect beginning Monday, Nov. 4, and validations will no longer be provided except in special cases. Parking will be free for the first hour. Thereafter, it will be:

- Free for under 1 hour
- \$5 for 1-2 hours
- \$10 for 2-3 hours
- \$15 for 3 or more hours (\$15 daily max)
