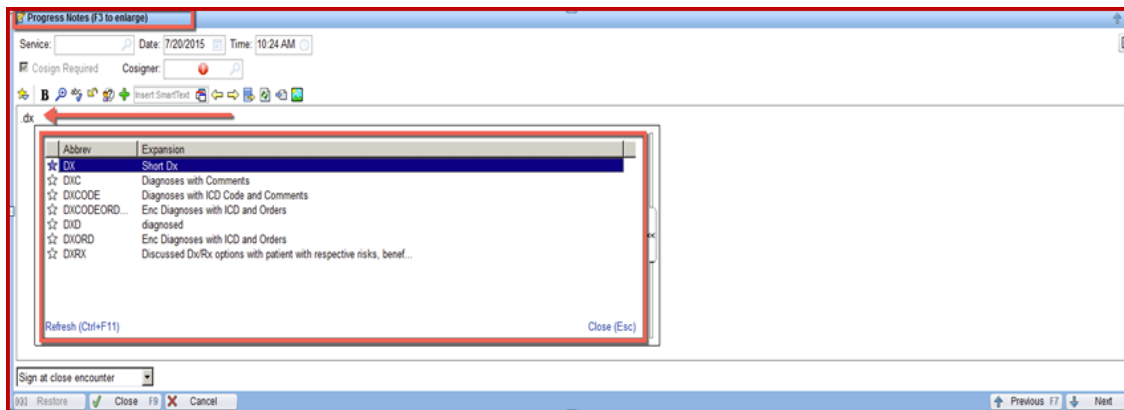


Using “Dot” Phrases To Pull Diagnoses Into Your Clinical Documentation

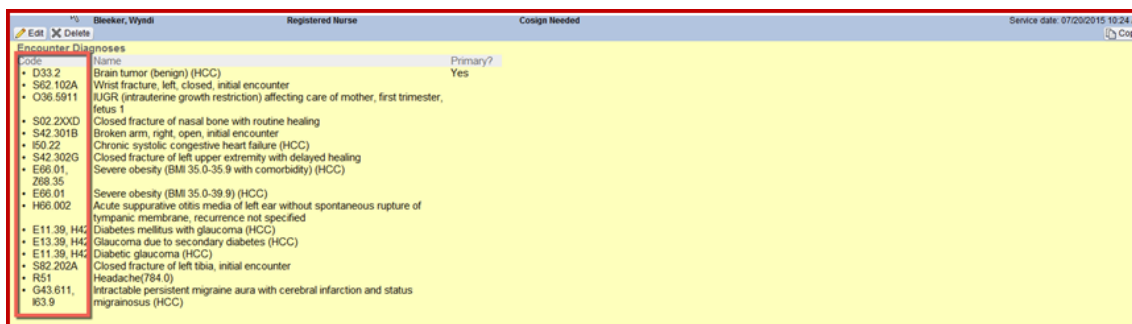
On **October 1, 2015** Cedars-Sinai will transition to the use of the ICD-10-CM and ICD-10-PCS code sets in accordance with a United States federal government mandate. Clinicians can use “dot” phrases to pull in diagnoses used in the patient’s problem list, visit diagnosis, order entry and other areas. This job aid describes the steps to pull in diagnoses into the clinical note. As a reminder this tool is currently available to CS-Link users.

Using a .DX or .PROB

After designating a diagnosis within the encounter diagnosis section or order entry, for example, clinicians can pull these diagnoses into the Progress Note. Within the Progress Note, enter “.dx” or “.prob” to see a list of options for pulling diagnosis information into your note. Notice there are different options from which users can select.



After selecting a “dot” phrase option, the diagnosis information will display within the note.
